The data world has witnessed dramatic changes owing to the digital revolution; not least the concept of data has changed and broadened. UN Members States are part of a much more complex data world comprising national statistical offices and systems, civil society, the private sector and international organizations. The 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development, the first global social contract ever, dramatically expanded the boundaries of official statistics, demanding a huge amount of statistical and conceptual development. To meet this challenge, the statistical community came together in an independent process to develop global indicator framework, harnessing both traditional and novel data sources, with a particular focus on leaving no one behind. Together, elements have highlighted the importance of data management and data governance. The 2030 Agenda has passed the half point, and it is clear the SDGs are off track. The world needs to accelerate progress; a key element of this acceleration in the digitalization of data. This transition will need to be supported by good data architecture and good data governance. The UN Statistical Commission has discussed the topic "Data Governance across systems: exploring strategies for official statistics" at his side-event during the 55th session.
